“German-Arab Graduate School 2017”

Institute of Law and Economics (ILE), Hamburg University

- **Program Description:** In a well-structured international research environment, the program offers the students the opportunity to write their theses (doctoral or master) on a trimester basis at the Institute of Law and Economics (ILE) of Hamburg University and with simultaneous enrollment at their home universities. Successful applicants will be awarded a scholarship during the research stay in Hamburg which will cover a monthly subsistence allowance and travel costs. During the research stay, the students are obliged to present their research ideas in a mini workshop at ILE, attend at least two courses in law and economics offered by ILE, and to participate in events and meetings in the fields of law and economics. Successful students will receive a certificate of enrollment from the University of Hamburg. The duration of stay in Hamburg for each student takes up to four months a year. Places are limited.
- **Courses offered (depending on the duration of stay in Hamburg):** Introduction to Law and Economics, Public Law and Economics, Competition Law and Economics, International Economics and Related Laws, Contract Law and Economics, Corporate Law and Economics, Quantitative Tools for Law and Economics, and others.
- **Language of the Program:** English
- **Start Date:** 01 January 2017
- **Enrollment Requirements:**
 - Bachelor or master degree in law, economics, statistics or political science with a minimum grade “**Very good**”.
 - Certificate of enrollment at home university.
 - Statement from home university indicating the expected date to finish your Master/PhD program.
 - Master/PhD proposal (Max. 3 pages).
 - Proof of English proficiency.
 - CV and motivation letter outlining the reasons for interest in joining this program.
- **Application Deadline: 11 November 2016**
